Lift truck operators have to be 18 years of age or over, in most countries. Local industry bodies approve Loader Training courses and require operators to acquire a certificate before utilizing this kind of heavy machines. A certificate is valid for four years in most areas. Businesses which hire employees to drive lift truck trucks can face serious liability issues if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

Untrained forklift operators can result in serious injuries and property damage because of incorrect operation of the machine. Training includes the proper loading and driving methods. Employees have to pass a written exam to be able to be certified. A business will usually designate a supervisor to be able to provide hands-on training to new employees. A qualified supervisor must have extensive training in forklift safety and be certified as a trainer.
