Introduction

Because of the various activities involved in warehouse operations, employees in warehouse environment may be at greater risk for accidents than those who work in areas with more limited activities. Therefore, companies place a top priority on warehouse safety.

Knowledge of possible warehouse dangers is key to avoiding accidents. Always be alert to potential dangers and methods to reduce risks. Do whatever is needed to avoid accidents.

General Hazards

Common types of hazard in a warehouse environment are trips, falls and slips. These accidents are usually caused when employees lose their balance or stumble over something which has not been put away correctly. Placing or removing items from storage could lead to a fumble or slip, potentially leading to both thing and employee to fall. The potential for falls, slips and trips is increased when employees are moving materials on different kinds of floor surfaces and on different levels. One more common danger is getting hit by falling items. This is normally caused by failure to correctly stack objects on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of improper lifting techniques are one more common hazard.

There are inherent risks in utilizing and working around workplace equipment. Accidents could often be caused from the improper utilization of forklift trucks, conveyors and hand trucks. Warehouse tools, like for instance pallets, skids, strapping and cutting tools, should be used carefully in unpacking, packing and loading.

Dangerous substances, combustible or flammable materials can pose hazards while being stored inside a warehouse. Employees should know how to take steps to protect themselves from health hazards when working around dangerous materials.
